Patient Safety—flavour of the day or enlightened way?

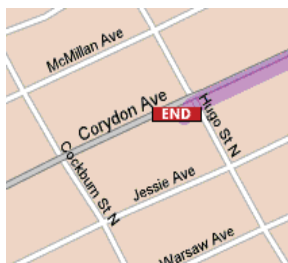
A discussion initiated by
